

Reading the Screen With the Mouse Webinar Answers

1. To toggle between the mouse pointer and WE cursor, press the Numpad minus key.
2. To move the mouse around the screen, press the following keys (with number lock turned off):
 - A. Top left: Numpad 7
 - B. Top right: Numpad 9
 - C. Bottom left: Numpad 1
 - D. Bottom right: Numpad 3
 - E. One line up: Numpad 8
 - F. One line down: Numpad 2
 - G. Character prior: Numpad 4
 - H. Character next: Numpad 6
3. To move the mouse by word, press the following keys:
 - A. Previous word: Insert – Numpad 4
 - B. Next word: Insert – Numpad 6
4. To read the current line, press Numpad 5.
5. To move the mouse by sentence or paragraph, press the following keys:
 - A. Previous sentence: Insert – Numpad 1
 - B. Current sentence: Insert – Numpad 2
 - C. Next sentence: Insert – Numpad 3
 - D. Previous paragraph: Control – Insert – Numpad 1
 - E. Current paragraph: Control – Insert – Numpad 2
 - F. Next paragraph: Control – Insert – Numpad 3
6. To route the mouse to the cursor, press Insert – Numpad Plus. To route the cursor to the mouse pointer, press Numpad Plus.
7. To move to the next clip, press Insert – Numpad 9. To move to the previous clip, press Insert – Numpad 7. To label a graphic, press Control – Shift - E.
8. To perform a Window-Eyes mouse find, press Control – Shift – F.
9. To perform a mouse drag and drop, press Insert – Numpad delete.
