

Using the Internet with Window-Eyes: Answers

1. The following web browsers are fully supported by Window-Eyes: Mozilla Firefox and Internet Explorer.
2. To get to the address bar, press Alt-D.
3. The main navigation hot keys in Browse Mode are as follows:
 - A. Headings: H or Shift-H
 - B. Links: L or Shift-L
 - C. Text: X or Shift-X
 - D. Controls: C or Shift-C
 - E. Tables: T or Shift-T
 - F. Paragraphs: P or Shift-P
4. To turn Browse Mode off when on an edit box, press Enter. When on other parts of a web page, toggle Browse Mode on and off by pressing Control-Shift-A.
5. To prevent web sites like Google from turning Browse Mode on automatically, load the Enhanced Auto Load app.
6. To navigate between the search results in Google, press H.
7. To access the Page Navigation dialog, press Insert-Tab.
8. To get into table mode, press Control-Numpad +.
9. To read cell headers in a table, press Control-Shift-H.
10. To search for text when using Browse Mode, press Control-Shift-F.
11. To adjust the Browse Mode verbosity settings, press Insert-V.
